Events Organised in the month of February 2023

1. State Level Science, Mathematics & Environment Exhibition

The centre in collaboration with State Council of Education Research & Training organized State Level Science, Mathematics & Environment Exhibition and Rashtriya Bal Vaidnyanik Pradarshani from 06.02.2023 to 08.02.2023 in which total 82 students displayed their projects. Total 1516 students, teachers and general public witness the exhibition.

2. Science Seminar for Teachers

The centre in collaboration with State Council of Education Research & Training organized a seminar for teachers on topic Scientific Innovation for Sustainable Future on 07.02.2023 in which Dr. Rajesh Pednekar, Head and Associate Professor, Department of Chemistry from Dnynprasarak Mandal's college & Research Centre conducted the seminar and interacted with the teachers. Total 142 teachers attended the seminar.

3. Teachers Training Program
